TOURNAMENT RULES

Tournament Rules and Regulations

This tournament operates under SA Schools Squash and Squash SA Rules and Codes of Conduct.

1. ACCOMMODATION

- Respect & Responsibility: All participants must abide by rules and respect others.
- Quiet Hours: No noise after 22h00.
- Cleanliness: No littering in corridors, stairs, or bathrooms; keep bathrooms neat.
- Property: Do not remove bedding. Report broken items/vandalism to Andrew Morgan. Visiting provinces are directly responsible for any property damage.

2. DISPUTES & DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

- Disputes and Disciplinary Committee will be appointed at the first managers' meeting per SA Schools Squash IPT Rules.
- Offenders may be called before this committee and can face disqualification.

3. MANAGERS' RESPONSIBILITIES

Managers are responsible for their players' safety and well-being at all times.

4. FIXTURES & PLAY

- Attire: Appropriate sportswear and COMPULSORY PROTECTIVE EYEWEAR must be worn.
- Punctuality: Players must arrive at courts AT LEAST FIFTEEN MINUTES before their scheduled team event.
 - Order of Play: (RECONCILE: Choose one)Option A: 3, 4, 5, 2, 1
 - Option B: 5, 4, 3, 2, 1
- Match Format: All matches are best of five games (to 15 points, with lead by two at 14-all).

5. MARKING & REFEREEING (M&R)

- Each team provides a marker or referee.
- The first match's marker/referee is determined by coin toss/spin, then alternates per match.
- No player may officiate more than once per IPT fixture (exceptions for illness/injury, decided by managers).
- · Players, spectators, or parents must NOT interfere with officials' decisions.

6. SCORING SYSTEM

- 1.1 point awarded per game won.
- 2. Team winning most matches in a fixture wins the fixture.
- 3. Five (5) bonus points awarded to the fixture-winning team.
- 4. A team winning all section matches in a round robin wins the section, regardless of total points.
- 5. Two-Way Tie: Head-to-head fixture result determines the winner.
 - Three-Way Tie: (RECONCILE: Choose one or clarify)Option A: Points between the three teams in a triangular format decide. If still tied, head-to-head result between remaining two.
 - Option B: Total points will be the decider; Province with most points wins.

7. MATCH RESULT SHEETS

• All match result sheets must be signed by BOTH managers and placed in the results box at courts end of each session.

8. LIABILITY

- Players participate at their own risk. Organisers (SA Schools Squash, Squash SA, KZN Schools Squash, host clubs) are not responsible for injuries.
- 9. TEAM ORDER & WITHDRAWALS (U13 IPT & U11 Festival)
 - A player may withdraw and return later; the team forfeits that specific match position.
- Players DO NOT move up the order. This applies also to suspended/expelled players.
- 10. DISCIPLINE (GENERAL & ON-COURT)
 - · Players are subject to school discipline, upholding high standards of dress and behavior on and off court.
 - On-Court Misconduct: (RECONCILE: Choose one disciplinary pathway)Option A (Graduated): First offence (e.g., emotional outburst, dropping racket): point awarded against. Second offence: game awarded against. Repeated: match awarded to opponent.
 - Option B (Less Graduated): First offence (e.g., emotional outbursts, dropping racquets, verbal abuse): game awarded against. Persistent behavior: match awarded to opponent.
